IMPROVING STREET LIGHTING IN ACCRA



THE "STREET LIGHTING ENHANCEMENT PROJECT"

The Street Lighting Works under the Ghana Power Compact, being implemented by the Millennium Development Authority, (MiDA), will involve improvement in the quality of lighting on a total of 440km of selected Streets in Accra. 14,287 street lights, fitted with energy-efficient and durable luminaires, will be fitted as upgrades to existing lights or as new installations.

The street lighting enhancement Works come under the Energy Efficiency and Demand Side Management Project of the Compact Program. When completed, it is expected to reduce electricity consumption for street lighting by 40%, reduce the cost-burden on Assemblies and contribute to improved road safety and the security of road users at night.
