		We note from the documents received that the base specifications and drawings show mainly concrete and masonry and does not include a section on structural steel. Kindly confirm whether as a design and build project, the bidder is at liberty to choose the construction materials so long as they conform to standards and the performance requirements.	We can confirm that the bidder is at liberty to propose construction materials so long as they are equivalent to the base specifications and conform to standards and performance requirements: Materials, components, and workmanship shall be of good quality and in accordance with the Ghana Standards, British Standards, Agreement Certificates and Codes of Practice prescribed.
1	GEN		Therefore, for the structural columns, instead of structural reinforced concrete columns, the bidders are free to propose steel columns over concrete piers and footings.
			Structural steel columns in lieu of reinforced concrete are acceptable with detailed design completed by the design-build contractor.
			The Bidders should note that this is a competitive procurement and so pricing, along with technical compliance, are both important.
